

Student Competition for the collection of material and presentation on the topic of:

"The accession of Cyprus to the European Union and our Benefits"

The Europe Direct Nicosia — University of Cyprus is organising a student competition centred on the topic of: "The accession of Cyprus to the European Union and our Benefits." The competition aims to gather various forms of information (such as texts, articles, photos, videos, etc.) pertaining to Cyprus's journey in joining the European Union and the benefits of our membership. The presentation of the material can be in the form of a video or PowerPoint presentation.

Who can participate?

The competition is open to students of the 1st, 2nd and 3rd grade of Gymnasium (middle school) and the 1st and 2nd grade of Lyceum (high school), either as a group (up to 3 students) or individually. Entries must be the own creation of the students.

Evaluation criteria

The evaluation criteria are:

- 1. The originality/authenticity and creativity of the presentation (30 points)
- 2. The right choice of material (identifying important elements). (30 points)
- 3. The content and expressive competence of the text (verbal or written). (20 points)
- 4. The synergy (creative relationship) between the chosen semiotic systems (e.g. verbal and visual). (20 points)

The material will be graded with a perfect score of 100.

Duration

From 3 to 10 minutes.

Participation

The final presentation should be sent to eudirect@ucy.ac.cy by 1st July 2024 at 23:59pm. The material must be sent via WeTransfer.

You can see how to send files via WeTransfer here. Along with the presentation/video, participants will be required to send the relevant registration form.

The size of the presentation should not exceed **2GB**.

Other instructions


For participation in the competition and in cases where students are featured in the video they may create, written and signed **parental/guardian consent is required** which has been sent to schools along with the present.
